May God rebuke him, we humbly pray and do Thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host by the power of God cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl throughout the world seeing the ruin of souls. Amen.

THE APOSTLES' CREED (2 ~ 8)

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. O my God, I love You above all things, with my whole heart and soul because You are all-good and deserving of all my love. I love my neighbor as myself for love of You. I forgive all who have injured me and ask pardon of all whom I have injured. Amen.

THE ANGELUS (3 ~ 8)

The angel of the Lord declared unto Mary---And she conceived by the Holy Spirit. Hail Mary...

Behold the handmaid of the Lord---Be it done unto me according to Thy Word. Hail Mary...

And the Word was made flesh---And dwelt among us. Hail Mary...
